Reflections

Each incremental decision we've made as a community has led us to where we are today. Your partnership, your collaboration, your support of the downtown experience, as a whole, has changed the momentum of this community.

Building community with the community is a core value of our organization. It's the reason we invite people into conversations, it's the reason we include people in planning, it's the reason we invite people to the table. Quite literally.

This was emphasized more than ever when we hosted our first community dinner in Perry Square in the fall. As we ended our first Pay-What-You-Can Farmers' Market, we chose to share the abundance of the harvest season with our neighbors far and wide. We did this by inviting them to share a meal and our company together at one big table. Over 250 people from across the community were fed that evening—nourished by both the food and by the pleasure of sharing in each other's experiences.

This might have been the most profound and impactful event we've hosted to date.

As we reflect on the milestone of 20 years serving this community, we recommit to more purposeful community building that enhances the downtown experience for all.

Environment

The Erie Downtown Partnership (EDP) is an advocate for public space infrastructure and amenities, as well as providing resources that improve downtown's built environment. In 2024, in partnership with urban planning firm Smith Group, we facilitated six public engagement sessions to help inform the Energize Downtown Erie Public Space Plan. Over 150 people met us at Blasco Library, Ember + Forge, Erie Ale Works, and last year's annual meeting to provide feedback on spaces they would like to spend more time in, as well as what activities and amenities are missing from downtown.

Working with key partners downtown, we will soon have our final draft available for the public to review further and provide additional feedback. This will be the foundation of our work to create public and third spaces that create linkages, access, comfort, and sociability.

What's Next

In 2025, we will open another round of our Façade Improvement Grant, which will assist property owners with eligible facade improvements up to \$10,000 to accompany additional grant opportunities through the EDP. We will prioritize transformational improvements and use of the Downtown Design Guidelines as a resource for changes to historic properties. Projects that enhance key corridors and positively impact commercial blocks help increase property values and attract quality tenants. Preventing blight and vacancies is essential to elevating the standard of care throughout downtown's built environment.

We are also collaborating with the City of Erie's Historic Review Commission to create both a National and Local Historic Designation which includes the Downtown Improvement District. Stakeholder meetings will be held with property owners to provide specific information on both the updates to the guidelines and the accompanying designations.

Environment What's Next

The Ambassador Service Request Portal will launch in 2025, allowing businesses to directly request assistance from the Safety and Hospitality Ambassador team. Requests will allow the ability to upload photos, priority levels, and contact information. An Ambassador will be assigned to the request and stakeholders will be notified that their request has been completed with photos if needed. This new initiative is made possible by a grant from FirstEnergy Corporation.

Economic Vibrancy

Programs and services of the EDP support positive economic growth by aligning these with the current needs of the business community allowing for flexibility when needs shift.

We continue to welcome businesses into the new gift card program as well as heavily promote businesses within the district through ribbon cuttings, event collaboration and cross-promotion, and social media. Our Small Business Saturday event and vendor markets attract local creators and makers, some of whom aspire to have a business location downtown.

What's Next

In addition to EDP's longstanding Facade Improvement Grant, we will introduce three new grants to support businesses in the commercial core. These new grants include a \$20,000 Transformation Grant for substantial renovations to a building that enhances the surrounding block, a \$5,000 Outdoor Dining Grant to help businesses establish or expand vibrant spaces to enhance the pedestrian and customer experience, as well as a \$5,000 Signage Grant to assist new and existing businesses with better signage. Applications and guidelines will be available on our website this Spring. These grants are reimbursement grants and will require matching funds.

Events

We experienced incredible growth in 2024 in not only the events we offered, but also the partnerships and community connections we were able to forge through those events and activation in Downtown Erie. Several major events embodied our ongoing intention to expand our programming throughout the year.

In April 2024, Erie was in the path of totality during a **total solar eclipse**, a once-in-a-lifetime astronomical event that drove major tourism to the area. EDP engaged in planning intentional events around the eclipse starting in 2022 through a local committee convened by Visit Erie. Our event in Perry Square welcomed hundreds and provided a space for partners like Gannon University, the Erie County Library, and the expERIEnce Children's Museum to plan educational engagements and learning opportunities. A visit from NASA astronaut and PA native Woody Hoburg and PA Governor Josh Shapiro helped transform the day into a major local event, one of the largest eclipse watch parties in the City.



Pay-What-You-Can Farmers Market

In June, we partnered with several local farms and community organizations to begin a new farmers market model in downtown. The **Pay-What-You-Can Markets** started on the East Side as a program of Wild Field Farm and Grow and Glow Urban Collaborative. With those partners, as well as Raintree Farms, the Conscious Food Project, the Food Policy Advisory Council of Erie, Groundwork Erie, and Erie Farm to School, we were able to bring a farmers market model to downtown that more effectively served the downtown population and distributed more than 7,500 pounds in locally-produced food throughout the growing season. We were also able to bookend the season with two amazing **community meal events**: a **screening of Farming While Black** and **dinner in the park on Juneteenth**, and a free **Community Harvest Dinner** in October with a meal prepared entirely from locally-grown produce and ethically-sourced staple crops. The shift to a community-focused model for food distribution aims to build social trust more effectively through food security, stabilize and improve the downtown economy, as well as support small-scale urban farmers and food producers. An investment in this hyper-local system is an investment in being able to connect our downtown population to healthy, fresh food and basic resources.

Finally, strong partnerships with the City of Erie, Erie Arts and Culture, the Erie Art Museum, Catholic Charities, the Multicultural Resource Center, and the US Committee for Refugees and Immigrants yielded our first ever large-scale **World Refugee Day Celebration** in Perry Square on June 20th. This event celebrated many different refugee populations in Erie and showcased music, dance, and other performances on the stage with multicultural artisans and food vendors throughout the park.

We saw growth across many other events as well, including our **Movie Mondays series**, the **Perry Square Summer Concert Series**, our **Sunrise Yoga at Dobbins Landing**, and large events like **Erie Winter Carnival**, the **St. Patrick's Day Parade**, and **Fall Fest**. Throughout the year, our continuous goal is to draw density to downtown through regular activation of public spaces with safe, family-friendly, engaging, and uniquely local community events that contribute to the safety, vibrancy, and overall wellbeing of downtown.
